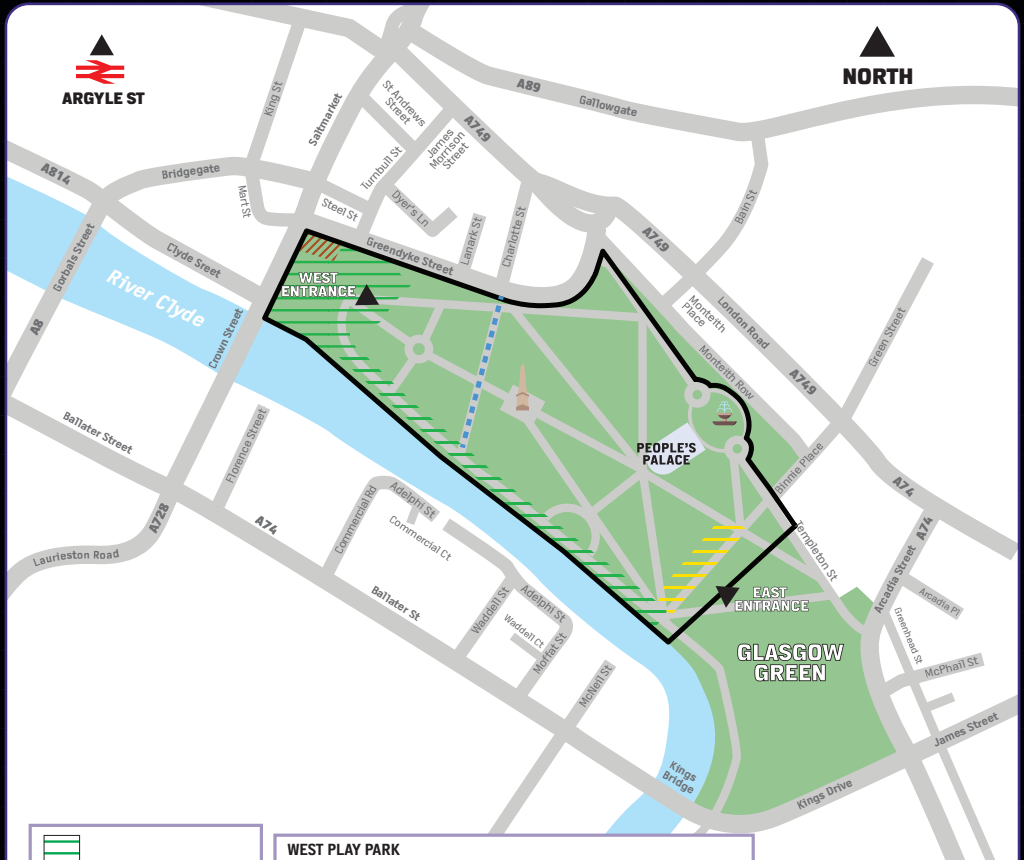

# ACCESS TO THE PARK

Construction of the event fence will begin from **Friday 05 June** and is expected to be completed by **Monday 08 June**. For safety reasons and in line with construction regulations, we will have to restrict access to agreed areas of the Green from **Friday 05 June to Saturday 27 June 2026**.

Following our local community engagement, we understand and appreciate the importance of maintaining use and access to as much of the Green as possible for the public. Please see the information below on the dates and times that various areas will be open to the public.

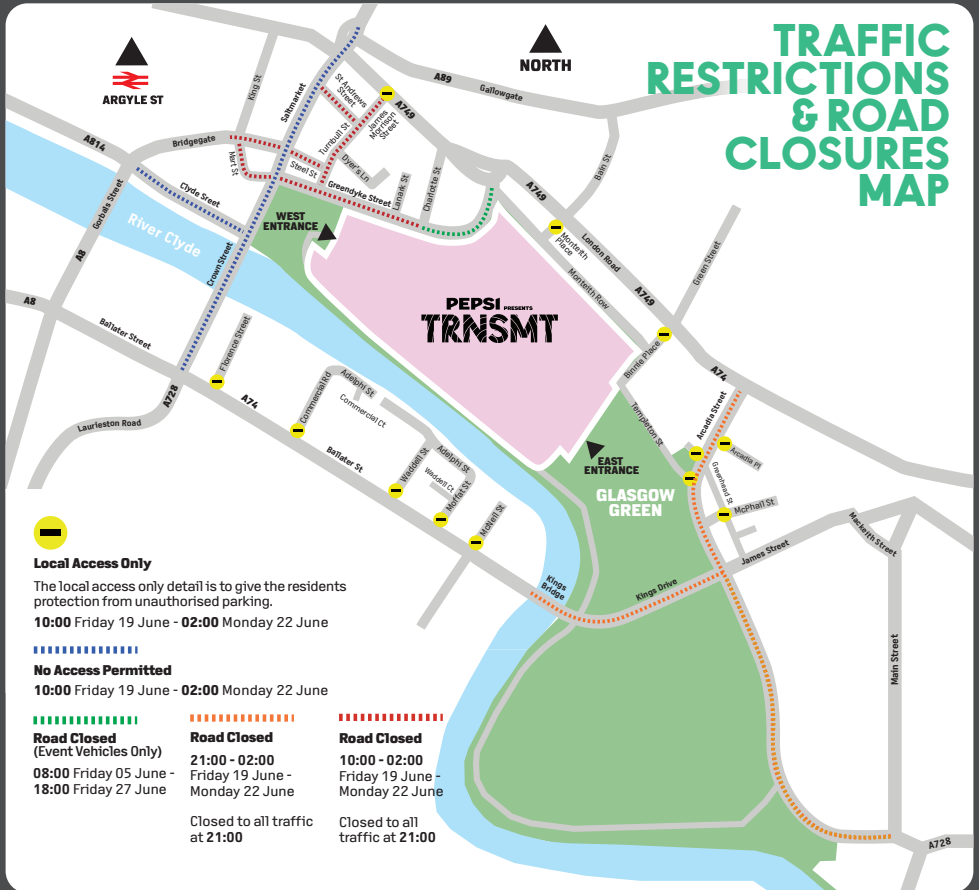
